DAY 1: VIENNA ARRIVAL - VIENNA

ARRIVAL TO VIENNA AIRPORT AND TRANSFER TO VIENNA CITY CENTRE.

Vienna. The capital of Austria.

Vienna - the capital and largest city in Austria, and its cultural, economic and political centre. As the former home of the Habsburg court and its various empires, the city has the trappings of the imperial capital as it once was, and the historical city centre is included on the UNESCO World Heritage List. Get a sense of the lustre and glory of the old empire by visiting St. Stephen's Cathedral, the Spanish Riding School and the Giant Ferris Wheel at the Prater.

DAY 2: VIENNA

BREAKFAST AT HOTEL.
MEET WITH A **LICENCED LOCAL GUIDE FOR A GUIDED TOUR OF VIENNA.**



See the St. Stephens Cathedral, the State Opera House, the magnificent Museum of Fine Arts with its world famous art treasures of the Habsburgs and the Natural History Museum, the cultural district the Museums Quartier, the Hofburg (the former Habsburg winter residence), the Parliament, the City Hall and the Burgtheater, etc.

IN THE AFTERNOON TIME FOR LUNCH AT LOCAL RESTAURANT & FREE TIME FOR INDIVIDUAL SIGHTSEEING & SHOPPING.

OPTIONAL VISIT OF **SCHÖNBRUNN CASTLE** - palace designed in the classic Rococo style of the 18th century with beautiful gardens. Schönbrunn Palace was not only an imperial residence and the setting for countless festivities, but also a place where famous artists and craftsmen from many different epochs created interiors of great beauty. All the rooms in the palace have their own stories to tell, stories on the margins of great historical events which are indicative of the lifestyle atmosphere and world view of the imperial era.

DAY 3: VIENNA – SALZBURG

AFTER BREAKFAST TRANSFER IN DIRECTION OF **SALZBURG**, FOR A HALF DAY SIGHTSEEING CITY TOUR & INDIVIDUAL EXPLORING OF THE CITY.



Salzburg. Romantic city in Mozart's style.

Known from "The Sound of Music" and as Mozart's birthplace, Salzburg is a city steeped in tradition and surrounded by nature that presents itself as a modern cultural center in the heart of Europe.

Salzburg owes its international fame not only to the film "The Sound of Music" and to Mozart but also to the unique charm of its cityscape and the beauty of its picturesque surroundings. The city's silhouette is unparalleled: Hohensalzburg Fortress, the baroque Cathedral, the Franciscan and Collegiate Church at the foot of the Mönchsberg and the mighty, legendary Untersberg in the distance. The entire historic center of Salzburg has been declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO which characterizes it as "an outstanding example of an architectural ensemble that represents a significant period in man's history."

IN THE EVENING OPTIONAL dinner & attendance at Best of Mozart Concerts within the Fortress high above the rooftops of Salzburg.

DAY 4: SALZBURG - BLEED

AFTER BREAKFAST AT HOTEL TRANSFER IN DIRECTION OF **SLOVENIA & LAKE BLEED**.



Bled. The jewel of Alps.

Slovenia has only one island but its uniqueness makes it more attractive than many an archipelago. Sheltered by picturesque mountains, the island reigns in the middle of an Alpine lake. Its charm has made it a symbol for centuries of a town to which guests from all over the world love to return. This town, which has already existed for a thousand years, is Bled.

IN THE AFTERNOON FREE TIME TO EXPLORE BLEED ON YOUR OWN AND OVERNIGHT IN HOTEL IN BLEED.

DAY 5: BLED – BOHINJ – MT. VOGEL - LJUBLJANA

BREAKFAST AT HOTEL AND GUIDED HALF DAY TOUR OF BLED.

Embark pletna boat and ride to Bled island, visit church of St. Mary and experience the opportunity of making one wish come true by ringing the bell in the church. Proceed for visit medieval Bled castle standing on a high cliff overlooking Bled lake. Enjoy the astonishing scenery of the Julian Alps and the lake below the castle. The guests can visit castle museum, printing shop, wine cellar, herbal gallery and souvenir shop.



FREE TIME FOR LUNCH AT THE LOCAL RESTAURANT AND TRANSFER TO **BOHINJ AND MT. VOGEL – TRIGLAV NATIONAL PARK.**



Bohinj and Mt. Vogel. Preserved picture of the pure nature.

Visit to the Alpine Dairy Museum in Bohinj and enjoy a cable car ride to the Mt. Vogel (1650 meters asl) with extraordinary panoramas over the surrounding snowy mountains and valleys. It is a perfect spot for photo shooting – we hope to have sunny weather!

AFTER TAKING THE CABLE CAR DOWN TO THE VALLEY, DRIVE IN THE DIRECTION OF **LJUBLJANA**, THE CAPITAL OF SLOVENIA.

FREE TIME FOR INDIVIDUAL SIGHTSEEING IN LJUBLJANA, AND OVERNIGHT.

DAY 6: LJUBLJANA – POSTOJNA CAVE - OPATIJA

BREAKFAST AT HOTEL AND HALF DAY SIGHTSEEING TOUR OF LJUBLJANA.



Ljubljana. Capital of magical lifebeat.

Sightseeing tour includes a visit to the market, dragon bridge, robba's fountain, cathedral of st.nicholas etc.

During sightseeing take a ride with funicular railway to **Ljubljana castle** and climb the stairs to tower castle – enjoy panoramic view over ljubljana.

AFTER THE WALKING TOUR AND FREE TIME FOR LUNCH OR SHOPPING, TRANSFER IN DIRECTION OF POSTOJNA, FOR INSIDE VISIT OF **POSTOJNA CAVE**.



Postojna cave. The home of human fish.

The Postojna Caves, one of Slovenia's most spectacular natural sights, consist of a 27-kilometre underground system of passages, tunnels, galleries and chambers with wonderful dripstones. The caves, also famous for providing home to the olm (Proteus anguinus), an amphibian salamander endemic to subterranean waters of southern Europe, can be viewed from a small cave train.

TAKE A RIDE ON A POPULAR TOURIST CAVE TRAIN. AT THE LAST STATION WE WILL MEET A GUIDE AND JOIN A WALKING TOUR OF THE CAVE. ADMIRE THE SIGHTS OF STALACTITES AND STALAGMITES AND SEE THE 'HUMAN FISH', THE LARGEST AND MOST FAMOUS CAVE ANIMAL IN POSTOJNA CAVE

AFTER CAVE VISIT TRANSFER IN DIRECTON OF CROATIA and **OPATIJA**, one of the first tourist resorts on the Mediterranean coast, also known as "the Croatian Nice". Evening stroll along the sea promenade, refreshing sea breeze and delicious local seafood will stay in your memory for a long time.

DAY 7: OPATIJA – PLITICE NATIONAL PARK - ŠIBENIK

AFTER BREAKFAST DRIVE TO PLITVICE NATIONAL PARK AND SIGHTSEEING TOUR OF ONE OF THE MOST VISITED NATIONAL PARKS IN EUROPE.



Plitvice lakes. Inspiring creation of nature.

Sixteen small lakes interconnected with waterfalls that created a deposition of travertine, a special kind of limestone, constitute the main attraction of the park.

AFTER THE TOUR CONTINUE TOWARD ŠIBENIK.

Nestled in the heart of Dalmatia, where the river Krka flows into the Adriatic Sea, the city of Šibenik will enchant you with ancient charms. Upon arrival, walk around the city of Šibenik which architecture is protected by UNESCO. Overnight in Šibenik.

DAY 8: ŠIBENIK – KRKA NATIONAL PARK – TROGIR - SPLIT

AFTER BREAKFAST DRIVE IN DIRECTION OF KRKA NATIONAL PARK, FOR A SIGHTSEEING TOUR.



Krka National Park is one of the Croatian national parks, named after the river Krka that it encloses. It is located along the middle-lower course of the Krka River in central Dalmatia, in Šibenik-Knin county, downstream Miljevcı area, and just a few kilometers northeast of the city of Šibenik.^[1] It was formed to protect the Krka River and is intended primarily for scientific, cultural, educational, recreational, and tourism activities.



AFTER VISIT OF NATURAL WONDER AND FREE TIME FOR A LUNCH, DRIVE TO **TROGIR**.

Spend some time sightseeing one of Croatia's most beautiful towns Trogir. It's a small town and its sights are conveniently clustered together, making it an easy walk and easy to understand why it is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Climb the stairs of St. Lawrence cathedral bell tower and enjoy the panorama of the old town stony houses.

IN LATE AFTERNOON DRIVE TOWARDS **SPLIT**, FOR FREE TIME AND OVERNIGHT.

DAY 9: SPLIT - DUBROVNIK

BREAKFAST AT HOTEL AND HALF DAY SIGHTSEEING TOUR OF **SPLIT**.



Sightseeing in Split starts with the awesome Diocletian's Palace, and its marble streets scattered with Roman ruins.

Visit of a historical city built by the Romans.
Visit Diocletian's Palace, Jupiter's palace, the open market and St. Dominus Cathedral

AFTER SIGHTSEEING FREE TIME FOR LUNCH AND SHOPPING AND DRIVE IN DIRECTION OF **DUBROVNIK**.

Dubrovnik "the Pearl of the Adriatic" is a standout attraction, a perfectly preserved baroque city-state. Upon late afternoon arrival free time to explore city on your own.
