The Belgrade Fortress

It was erected on the hill above the junction of the Sava and Danube rivers at the end of the 1st Century as the permanent camp of the Roman Legion Flavia Felix. During the course of history, it underwent various additions, was razed to the ground, rebuilt and remodelled on numerous occasions.

The National Museum

It is the most significant, the oldest and central Serbian museum. After over a hundred and sixty years of growth and development, from collecting rarities to comprehensive presentation of cultural heritage of Serbia and Europe, it has 34 archeological, numismatic, artistic and historical collections today

The Residence of Princess Ljubica

It was erected by order of Miloš Obrenović in 1831. By its architectural composition and arrangement, the palace belongs to the Balkan style, with some western Baroque elements.

The House of Flowers

The house of flowers and its accompanying museums dedicated to the memory of Josip Broz Tito offer visitors a glimpse into both the life and times of the man and his conflicted legacy.

Nikola Tesla Museum

It is a unique institution of science and culture in Serbia and in the world. It is the only museum in the world which preserves the original and personal inheritance of Nikola Tesla.

The Old Palace

The Royal Palace of the Obrenović dynasty of Serbia, presently housing the City Assembly of Belgrade, was built between 1882 and 1884.

Military Museum

It is situated on the Belgrade Fortress, in the oldest part of Belgrade. With its well known exterior, Museum is one of the fortress' symbols.

Milos Orenovic house

After having built the residence for his wife and children in the town of Belgrade, Knez Miloš Obrenović raised this lodging for himself in Topčider, in 1831-1834.

Skadarlija

The old bohemian quarter of Belgrade dates back to late 19th and early 20th century. It was back then when its kafane (taverns and restaurants) were a meeting place for many of the greatest figures of the cultural scene of the period. It is often compared with the Montmartre in Paris, both for its appearance and the cheerful, vigorous artists' atmosphere.

The Temple of Saint Sava

It is an Orthodox church which is dedicated to Saint Sava, founder of the Serbian Orthodox Church. The church is being built at the place where in 1595 Sinan Pasha had the holy relics of St. Sava burned at the stake, after he had them brought over from the Mileševa Monastery. Because of its dominant position in Belgrade's cityscape, it represents the most monumental building in the city.

Ada Ciganlija

On the river Sava, close to where it flows into the Danube, just 4 km from the city center, lies Ada Ciganlija, at one time an island, now a peninsula. Covered with thick deciduous trees and dotted with clearings and fields, Ada has become the largest, most beautiful and most popular picnic spot, bathing beach and place to relax in Belgrade. The Sava Lake is surrounded by more than 7 km of well-kept shingle beaches, whose water is warmer and cleaner than in the river. The lake is ideal for mass recreation.

Around Belgrade

Novi Sad (88 km) and Sremski Karlovci (73 km)

Novi Sad owns its world reputation to one of the best European festivals – the famous Exit Festival. But, besides Exit, this city has a lot to offer, namely: Petrovaradin fortress (one of the best preserved monuments of military architecture), Fruška Gora national park, surrounding salašes for relaxation, restaurants for gourmants, never-closing night-clubs, and Šrtand, best beaches on the Danube River, Sremski Karlovci (small town on the Danube bank. It is rightly called a town-museum, due to its remarkably preserved town nucleus in the baroque style, dating from the 18th and 19th centuries. You can make a tour of all the attractions on foot)

Kovačica (50 km)

Kovačica is a town and municipality located in the South Banat District of Vojvodina, Serbia. It is widely known by its naïve art. Naïve art a classification of art that is often characterized by a childlike simplicity in its subject matter and technique. While many naïve artists appear, from their works, to have little or no formal art training, this is often not true.
